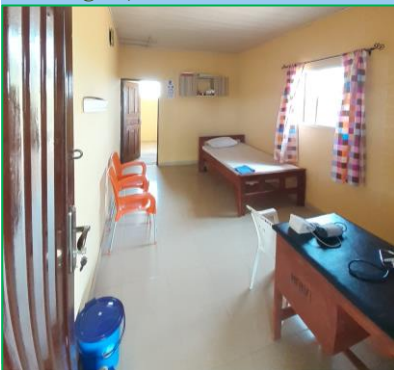


As the first beneficiaries of this project,

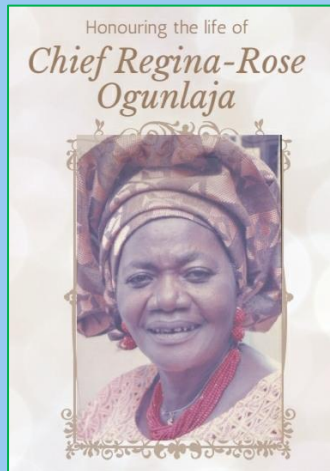
