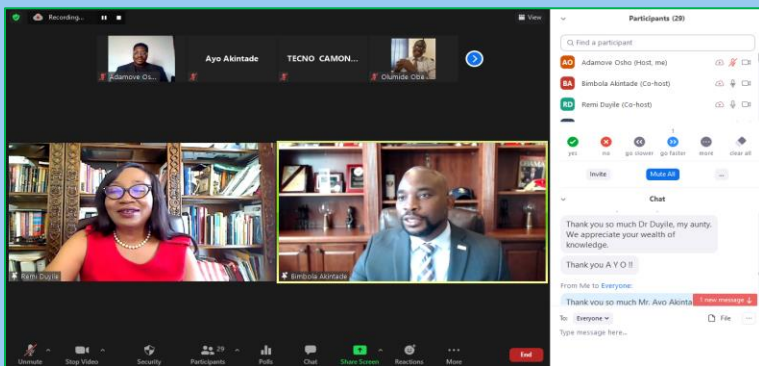
## HFN MONTHLY LECTURE SERIES FINANCIAL LITERACY

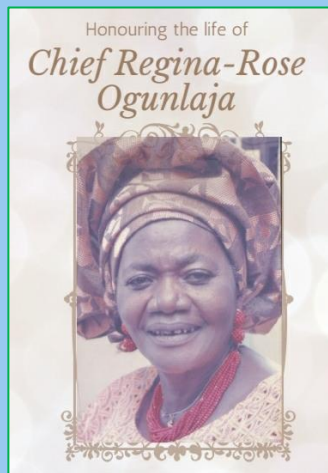
