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## MEET THE TEAM



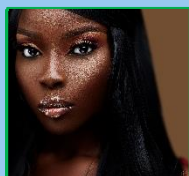
### Prof. Abimbola Akintade (Founder)

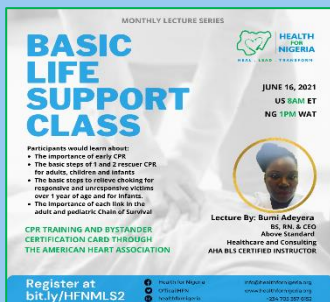

## HFN MONTHLY LECTURE SERIES BASIC LIFE SUPPORT TRAINING



On the 16<sup>th</sup> of June 2021, HFN hosted its second installment of the Monthly Lecture Series. This series caters to healthcare professionals and provides a platform for HFN nurses in the Nurse A School program to broaden their scope and add

more value to their experience with HFN. Ms. Bumi Adeyera who hosted this session is a certified BLS instructor from the American Heart Association (AHA). She led an interactive workshop session as she presented various topics including adult, child, and infant CPR as well as best practices in BLS procedures. Participants also had the opportunity to register to get their BLS certification and cards from the AHA.

## NURSE A SCHOOL HIGHLIGHTS HEALTH PROMOTION

## COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

This month we have a few highlights from our programs on impacts we have made in the community.

1) The Old Student's Association of Community Comprehensive School Awo, Ekiti, visited the school and was impressed by HFN's presence and impact. They had reached out to the school earlier and planned on donating a first aid box to the school but were pleasantly surprised to find a fully functional sickbay at the school. They reached out to Nurse Kemi Oke, and she spoke with them about HFN. The Association then decided to donate some medications and health supplies to the sickbay.



2) Nurse Folasade Ajiboye was joined by a volunteer in Ibadan for a health education and outreach program at a Gospel Of Faith Ministry International Church in Ibadan. Folasade spoke with them about sudden death,



answered questions, and addressed general misconceptions about causes of sudden death. After the talk, there was a general health screening for high blood pressure and blood glucose levels. Those with elevated levels were counseled and recommended to visit a nearby PHC or make a doctor's appointment. The ministers and congregation were grateful and invited us to return at a later date.
