### 12 Lead ECG Assessment: An Introduction for Healthcare Providers

On the 12<sup>th</sup> of May 2021, We hosted the inaugural lecture of our Monthly Lecture Series. This series is targeted at healthcare professionals and provides a platform for our Nurse A School nurses to broaden their scope and add more value to their time working with HFN. Prof. Akintade launched this series by delivering the first

lecture and we plan to have more guest lecturers deliver in the upcoming installments.

### “NURSE A SCHOOL” LAUNCH EKITI STATE

HFN launched two Nurse A School Programs in public schools in Ekiti State on the 6<sup>th</sup> of May 2021. The two schools are Methodist Girls Highschool in Ifaki and Comprehensive Community High school in Awo. At Methodist Girls High School, we were joined by Mr. Ajayi the Director of Schools and the Deputy Director of Schools from the Ministry of Education (pictured @ right). The event also had a presentation by the students and an address from



Mr. Ajayi, The Principal and Mr. Osho. After the presentations, we were joined by the representatives from the Ministry of Health, the Principal, and a few students to commission the opening of the sick bay (pictured @ left).



Picture to the right is the interior of the sickbay which was a joint effort with the Old Student’s Association of Methodist Girls High School and HFN. Students and staff were excited and grateful for this initiative at their school.



We were received with a presentation from the students at Comprehensive Community High School in Awo. There was a cultural dance to welcome us and a drama presentation on the importance of immunization and the

dangers of self-medication. Mr. Osho also addressed the students and staff of the school on behalf of HFN. We were joined by the School Principal, Vice Principal, some staff members, and some of the student performers to commission the launch of the school sick bay.
