“NURSE A SCHOOL” EKITI

HFN Engaged the Ekiti State government in the fourth quarter of 2020 and began the process of establishing a presence in the State. We have currently started the



implementation of projects at 2 schools in the State. The first location (pictured to the left) is At Methodists Girls Highschool in Ifaki. The school has a population of about 500 students and employs over 60 staff.

The second location in Ekiti is Awo Community High School. The renovations to the space provided (picture to the right and below) were recently completed and the plans to launch the project



are underway. Both projects, at Ifaki and Awo, would be launched in tandem, the specific date for the launch will occur on the 6th of May 2021.
