### **Prof. Abimbola Akintade (Founder)**

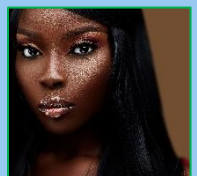

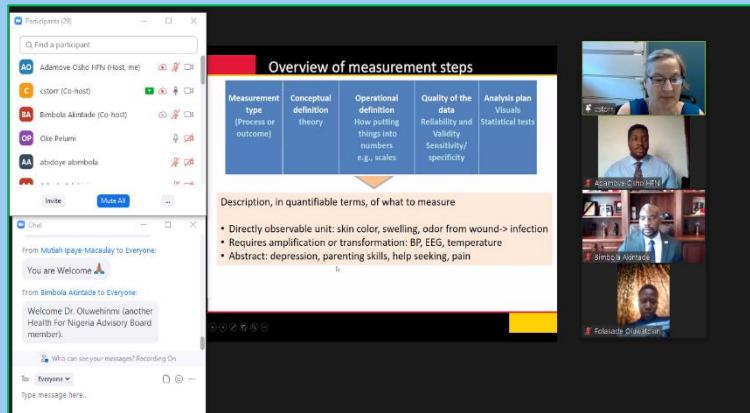

## HFN MONTHLY LECTURE SERIES IMPORTANCE OF DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS

On the 18<sup>th</sup> of August 2021, Health For Nigeria (HFN) hosted the fourth lecture of ITS Monthly Lecture Series. This lecture was delivered by our guest lecturer Dr. Carla



Storr. The lecture centered on the importance of data, tools for data collection and some of its application towards evidence driven decision making. Dr. Carla Storr is a professor at the University of Maryland, Baltimore.

## COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

This month we would be highlighting the various efforts HFN has made through the Nurse A School program to impact communities across the partnering states. Apart from providing impactful clinical and educational services at the schools, HFN Nurses conduct health awareness education and promotion activities in their host communities.



Nurse Kemi Oke in Awo Community in Ekiti State partnered with one of the local community churches, providing health education and health promotion presentations.

Nurse Kemi also provided basic health screening to include blood pressure and blood glucose measurements for attendees. Individuals with measurements beyond the normal limits were referred to nearby PHC's.

Nurse Luro Adeola in Ode-Irele, Ondo state was invited to give a health promotion presentation at a women's conference hosted by a civil society organization. Attendees were grateful and asked several meaningful questions.
