MEET THE TEAM.



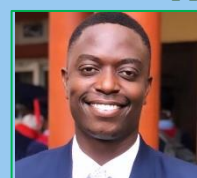
Prof. Bim Akintade (Founder)

NURSE A SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

This month we are highlighting the various efforts HFN has made through the Nurse A School (NAS) program to impact communities across partnering states. In addition to providing impactful clinical and educational services at the schools, HFN Nurses conduct health awareness education and promotion activities in their host communities to improve outcomes.



Teaching good oral health habits to kids is a necessary part of education. Nurse Iyabo Salami during a Health Club meeting at Ekunle High School 2 in Iseyin Oyo State educated students on oral hygiene and made sure they understood the importance of taking care of their teeth at a

young age. She introduced them to an effective oral hygiene routine, such as brushing twice daily and proper flossing strategies and techniques. She also demonstrated to them to prevent injuries. The goal of proper brushing techniques helps with fluoride treatments in order to prevent tooth decay.

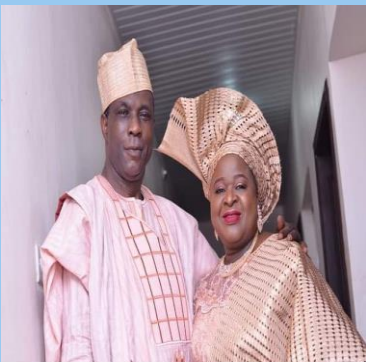
