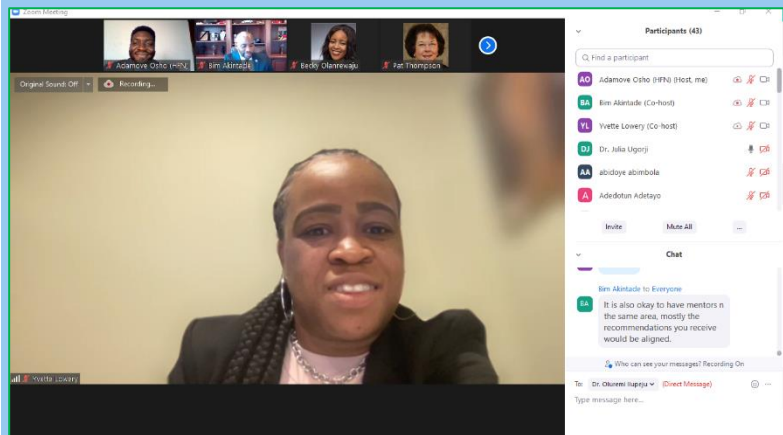
HFN MONTHLY LECTURE SERIES
